As well, we will be seeking volunteers to help with this great event.... So check your calendars to see if you are available that day!



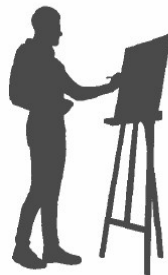
